What a Sponsorship Does

- Scholarships are intentional, limited, and values-aligned
- Sponsored students are selected through a structured application process
- Sponsorship fills the gap for students who would not otherwise be able to participate



Who Sponsors Support

- Families facing financial barriers
- Girls in grades 5-12 who demonstrate leadership potential
- Many first-generation leadership program participants
- Students navigating transitions (middle → high school, confidence gaps, new environments)

What Sponsored Students Receive

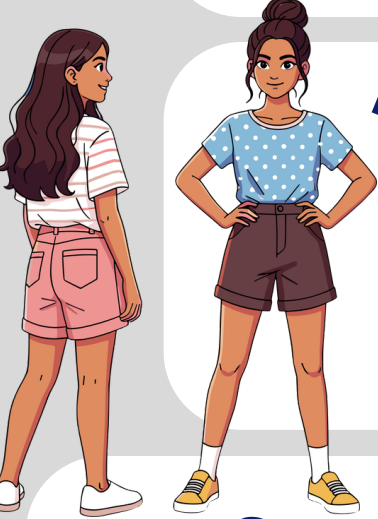
- HighHER TogetHER Leadership programming: LEADS, Leadership Labs, or Concentrations
- Access to skilled facilitators and near-peer mentors
- Curriculum focused on leadership skills, collaboration, confidence, and voice
- A cohort-based experience that emphasizes healthy competition AND a collaborative spirit
- Meals, materials, and program supplies



Accountability and Commitment

Scholarship recipients:

- Commit to attendance and participation
- Are held to the same expectations as full-pay students
- Are part of a cohort culture built on responsibility and respect
- Acknowledge program commitment as part of the application process



Sponsorship Investment

LEADS Grades 5-9

- **\$1800/year**
- **\$150/month**
- **Supports one LeadHER**

Covers tuition, Leadership Lab fee, curriculum materials and program participation

Leadership Concentrations Grades 9-12

- **\$1500/year**
- **\$125/month**
- **Supports one LeadHER**

Covers tuition, Leadership Lab fee, project support and program participation

Leadership Labs Summer Edition Grades 5-9

- **\$650/student**
- **Supports one LeadHER**

Supports one week of access to summer leadership programming
